## ORDINANCE # 1989-7

The Supervisors of the Township of Summit, County of Erie, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, being duly elected and authorized by law to act in the following manner, and believing this action to be in furtherance of the public health, safety and welfare of the people of Summit Township, hereby enact the following Ordinance:

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of Summit Township have reviewed a traffic and engineering study conducted for the purpose of determining whether a portion of Robison Road West should be designated a "No Parking Zone"; and

WHEREAS, the engineering and traffic study indicates that stopping, standing or parking in or on this portion of Robison Road West would constitute a safety hazard and/or that stopping, standing or parking in or on this portion of Robison Road West would unduly interfere with the free movement of traffic; and

WHEREAS, the portion of Robison Road West, which will be designated a "No Parking Zone" is already designated as an official bus stop and/or as a loading or unloading zone,

NOW THEREFORE, the Supervisors of Summit Township ordain as follows:

The Township highway commonly known as Robison Road West (S.R. 4024) shall be and hereby is designated to be a "No Parking Zone" in the following portion:

Segment ten(10) offset 1,960 feet from Route 19 to a point 2,194 feet from Route 19 on both on the north and south sides of Robison Road West.

Parking of any vehicles, as that term is defined in the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, 75 Pa.C.S.A. §102, along Robison Road West (S.R. 4024) in the above designated area shall be prohibited at all hours of the day.

Further, the No Parking Zone as described above shall be identified as such by the placement of approved signs within the designated area for the purpose of notifying all persons of the existence of the No Parking Zone.

Any person violating this Ordinance shall be guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine in the amount of \$15.00, as now provided in the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code (75 Pa. C.S.A. §3353) or in whatever amount 75 Pa.C.S.A. §3353 prescribes as a fine as hereafter amended.
