VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of Summit Township, Erie County, PA, have reviewed traffic and engineering studies for the purpose of determining whether parking should be permitted on certain roadways in the Township; and

WHEREAS, the traffic and engineering studies indicate that, for various reasons, as stated therein, establishing a parking prohibition, would be in furtherance of the public health, safety and welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Summit, Erie County, Pennsylvania, hereby ENACTS AND ORDAINS that:

Section 1: No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle, at any time, upon any of the roads, or parts of roads, as follows:

Johnson Road (T-653) - Route 97 to Old French Road (T-558), both sides

Section 2: The no parking prohibitions shall be identified by the placement of approved signs within designated areas for the purpose of notifying all persons.

Section 3: Any person who shall operate, park, or stop a motor vehicle, in violation of this Ordinance, upon conviction thereof, shall be liable for all fines and penalties imposed by the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code.
