SUMMIT TOWNSHIP ERIE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

ORDINANCE NO. 2008-01

VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

WHEREAS, the Supervisor of Summit Township, Erie County, Pennsylvania have the police power to regulate or prohibit the stopping, standing or parking of motor vehicles; and

WHEREAS, Summit Township has the police power to provide for and establish procedures governing the removal and impounding of any vehicles parked on highways, roads or public property of Summit Township in violation of a Summit Township ordinance;

WHEREAS, Summit Township has the power to designate enforcement officers of Summit Township to enforce and administer said ordinance;

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of Summit Township have reviewed a traffic and engineering study which has been conducted for the purpose of determining whether a portion of Schultz Road (T-560) from Route 97 (Perry Highway) to Pennbriar Drive (T-665), should be designated a "no parking zone"; and

WHEREAS, the engineering and traffic study indicates that stopping, standing or parking in or on this portion of Schultz Road would constitute a safety hazard in that the stopping, standing or parking in or on this portion of Schultz Road would unduly interfere with the free movement of traffic; and

WHEREAS, the designated portion of Schultz Road shall be designated a "no parking zone".

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF SUMMIT TOWNSHIP, ERIE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, HEREBY ENACTS AND ORDAINS THAT:

- Section 1. Parking Prohibition. No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle, at any time upon any of the roads or part of roads as follows: Schultz (T-560), from Route 97 (Perry Highway) to Pennbriar Drive (T-665), both sides.
- <u>Section 2</u>. Signs. No parking prohibition shall be identified by the placement of approved signs within the designated areas for the purpose of notifying all persons.
- Section 3. Fines. Any person who shall park, stand or stop a motor vehicle in violation of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof, shall be liable for all fines and penalties imposed by the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code as set forth at 75 Pa.C.S. Section 3353 and including any amendments thereto.
- Section 4. Removal. Any vehicle parked in the above designated "no parking zone" shall be subject to removal therefrom under the procedures specified in the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code 75 Pa.C.S. Section 3353 as existing or as hereafter amended.

Section 5. Towing and Storage. The owner of any vehicle removed from the above designated "no parking zone" shall, in order to secure the return of the vehicle, pay the costs of towing and storage of said vehicle. The possessor of the vehicle shall return the same to the owner upon payment of the costs specified herein. The removal and reclamation remedy and costs described above shall be in addition to the penalties imposed under 75 P.A.C.S. Section 3353.

Section 6. Administration. The administration of this ordinance and other parking ordinances adopted by Summit Township, including ordinance 1989-7, ordinance 1996-4 and ordinance 2000-8, shall be by the zoning officer or parking enforcement officer appointed by Summit Township. The zoning officer or parking enforcement officer shall administer these ordinances in accordance with its literal terms and shall not have the power to permit any construction or any use or change of use which does not conform to this ordinance. The zoning officer or parking enforcement officer is authorized to institute enforcement proceedings as a means of enforcement when acting within the scope of their employment.
