

ORDINANCE NO. 1991-2  
Summit Township  
Erie County, PA

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING WEIGHT LIMITS ON CERTAIN TOWNSHIP ROADWAYS, AND ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR OPERATING VEHICLES IN EXCESS OF SUCH LIMITS.

The Supervisors of the Township of Summit, County of Erie, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, being duly elected and authorized by law to act in the following manner, upon recommendation of the Township engineer, and review of the traffic and engineering study pertaining hereto, hereby enact and ordain as follows:

A. The Township roadway commonly known as Pagan Road shall be restricted to a vehicle weight limit of ten tons (20,000 pounds) gross vehicle weight from a point beginning at the intersection of Pagan Road and Edinboro Road (S.R. 0099); thence continuing on Pagan Road to the point at which the entrance to the Erie County Fire School is located upon lands owned by the Erie County Vocational Technical School. This restriction shall be effected by the placement of the proper traffic control devices in the proper locations as required by Pennsylvania Law and the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.

B. No vehicle in excess of ten tons (20,000 pounds) gross vehicle weight shall travel on that portion of the highway commonly known as Pagan Road designated in paragraph A without first entering into an Agreement with the Summit Township Supervisors providing for security against damage to said road because of being overweight, in an amount set by Resolution of the Supervisors. The minimum amount of security to Township shall be the amount

prescribed by and required by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.

C. Any person violating this Ordinance shall be subject to penalties as provided by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as set forth in Subsection 4902(g) of the Motor Vehicle Code (75 Pa.C.S.A. Subsection 4902(g)), as now existing or as hereafter amended.

Duly adopted by unanimous vote at a regular meeting of the Summit Township Board of Supervisors held on the 21st day of October, 1991.

Dear Supervisors:

Pursuant to your request, Urban Engineers has investigated the pavement load capacity of Pagan Road under general automobile traffic and under higher HS-20 truck loads. Our evaluation is based on the existing reported conditions and information obtained visually during a site visit.

Pagan Road from Edinboro Road (S.R. 0099) to Flower Road has a reported pavement structure consisting of 8-10 inches of gravel subbase with tar and chip surface. Pavement width varies but typically is 18 foot wide.

Based on our engineering review of these conditions, we recommend the roadway be posted for 10 Ton load limit in order to prevent significant reduction in the service life of the pavement.

For activities which will involve truck traffic with loads above the posted limit, a bond may be requested for the duration of the activity.
